



Young Artists Exhibit November 26 - December 7, 2019

BACKGROUND

Yellow Elephant Gallery encourages creative expression at all ages. To further encourage and recognize young artists, the gallery invites artists to submit art for an exhibit of work by young artists.

Young Artists is open to all artists aged 6 through 14 who are residents of Kankakee, Iroquois, Livingston, or Grundy Counties. Artists may or may not have been involved in formal art instruction. All work must be original art completed within the last year and not previously exhibited. Each artist may submit up to three pieces. Art can be any 2D or 3D medium including but not limited to photography, paint, sculpture, drawing, pottery, or video.

As part of Yellow Elephant Gallery's ongoing commitment to giving back to the local community, **five dollars of each entry fee will be donated to** *Project SUN*. Project SUN is a **S**trong and **U**nified **N**etwork dedicated to implementing a family-driven system of care that provides Kankakee County youth and their families multiple access points to a comprehensive, integrated mental health care system aimed at meeting the needs of the whole child. Project SUN is administered through the Community Foundation of Kankakee River Valley.

SUBMISSIONS

A non-refundable entry fee of \$15 is required from each artist at the time of submission. The fee applies to each piece submitted.

CONDITIONS

Yellow Elephant Gallery (YEG) reserves the right to refuse any work which includes inappropriate images. YEG is not liable for any claim for loss, theft or damage of any kind during transportation or exhibition. YEG will exercise usual

care in handling. YEG cannot be responsible for minor wear resulting from normal handling.

DELIVERY OF ACCEPTED WORK

The artist is responsible for door-to-door delivery/shipment of work. **Late entries** will not be accepted.

PRESENTATION

All selected work must be delivered ready for installation. No dimension of any work may exceed six feet. Flat work must be wired for hanging. Sculptures must be able to sit on a level surface and must be able to be moved by one person. Any special handling instructions must accompany the piece in writing. Artists will assume reasonable risk for damage for all unframed work and any other unconventional display preferences. Each entry must be clearly identified, where possible, on the bottom or back with artist's name and title of work. YEG reserves the right to reject previously accepted works due to inadequate framing/ mounting or for security/public safety reasons.

SALES

Works shall be for sale and priced by the artist. YEG will retain 30% commission on all exhibit sales. Payment to artists will be made upon the closing of the exhibit.

RETURN OF ACCEPTED WORK

The exhibit closes Saturday, December 7, 2019 at 2pm. Yellow Elephant Gallery is not responsible for work left over 30 days beyond the close of the exhibit.
